➤ Income + £16,130

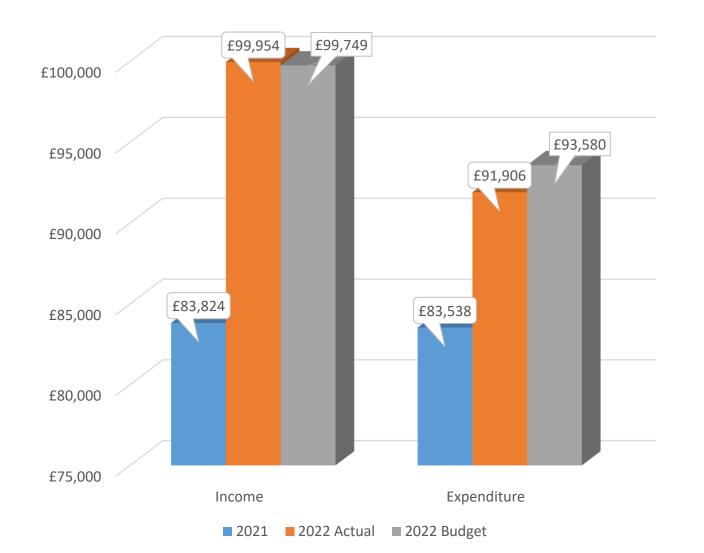
> Expenditure + £8,368

> Surplus £8,048



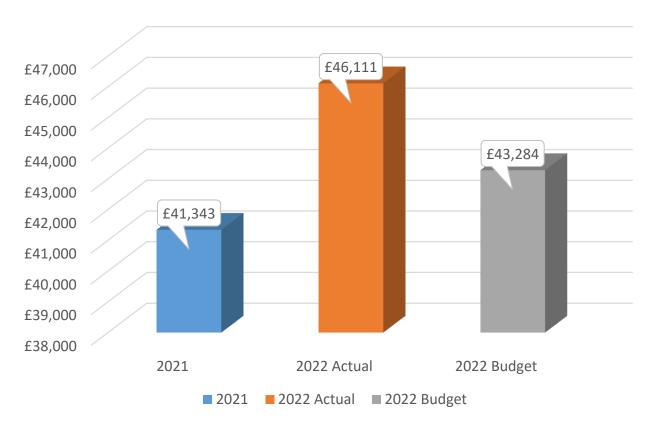


Total Church Collections: Plate – Standing Orders - Dona

Total Standing Orders

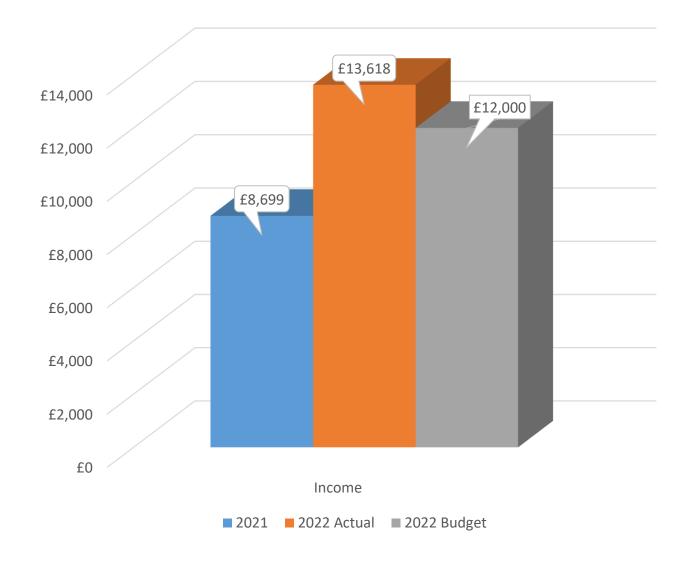
